Burial Location confirmed by personal visit by Bradford and Linda Needham.

Howard's birth certificate has the "Twin, Triplet, or Other" box checked. I (Brad Needham) haven't found evidence of a twin.

The Old Oregon Alumni Magazine incorrectly lists the year of death as 1974 instead of 1975.

Charter member and first church clerk of Emerald Baptist Church, Eugene, Oregon.  
General Chairman of the 1966 building committee of Emerald Baptist.

Howard was an aircraft observer in Eugene during WWII, because he was working at a vital job: Eugene Fruit Growers. There is a pack of aircraft observer playing cards and a pair of binoculars that belonged to him.

Howard participated strongly in the Boy Scouts. There is a "camp lucky boy" bandana and a scouting bugle that belonged to him.

The Albany Democrat story lists Frank's occupation as "Teacher" - that is inconsistent with the Return of Marriage form, which lists Mary as a teacher.

There is a family story that Frank was a chemistry teacher, and he took up farming because his doctor said that he had to give up chemistry teaching or die from the chemicals.

Death certificate lists burial at Portland Crematorium. It looks like Frank's remains were reinterred a few years

after his death, just like his mother's were. Portland Memorial Mausoleum, 14th and Bybee in Portland, Oregon, has a listing for Frank: "Needham, Frank Hart 24570 gone"

Frank, Mary, Howard, Floyd, and Esther appear in the 1930 census:

His obituary in 1949 says he moved to Oregon 43 years before. That would be 1906-ish, at age 34-ish. Albert Needham's obit says Albert came to Oregon in 1905.

Carole Sandberg Dawson's eulogy for her mother described Frank and Mary's farm as a 70 acre fruit farm northwest of Eugene.

When Linda and I (Brad Needham) visited Frank's niche at Rest Haven in Eugene in July 2002, we found his birth year on the niche incorrectly listed at 1822 rather than 1872. The Bardwell Descendants 2000 incorrectly lists Frank's birth year as 1873.

Red herring: Oregon State Archives has Number: Vol 3 pg 113 Year: 1895 Name: Needham, Frank Type: Census County: Marion. (the Needhams in Salem prior to 1970 seem to be related to these Needham's only through the Needhams of Wales, MA).

Letter from Walter Bruce Walrod to Howard and Lucille Needham reports that Frank Needham attended Brookside School in Ida Grove, IA.

Albany College closed its Albany campus in 1942 and moved to Portland under the name Lewis and Clark College.

Frank and Mary's wedding notice describes Mary as "a graduate of U O".

"Needham, Mary, class of 1908."

I [Brad Needham] am a little fuzzy on a family story about Mary Foshay being the first woman to graduate in some place/capacity. She wasn't in the first class at Albany College. Perhaps she was the first doctorate at U of O?

Mary's death certificate indicates that she lived the last few years of her life at Garber's Rest Home on Coburg Road.

Marriage Notes for Frank Needham and Mary Foshay:

Mary's Obit states she "...had been a resident of this community [Eugene] for 47 years." This is consistent with a wedding in 1908 or 1909.

Marriage notice in the Albany Democrat of 24 September 1909 describes the marriage as "yesterday", which would indicate 23 sept rather than 15 sept.

Evidently, THE 1879 'HISTORY OF CLINTON COUNTY IOWA' BY L. P. ALLEN mentions albert - I need to look this up.

"Historical Collections of Ida County" by Giles C. Moorehead, pg 19, lists, regarding the fair:  
Supt. Art Hall, Albert Needham - that is, he ran the Art Hall at the fair. It also lists:  
Board of Directors: Albert Needham....

Estate papers of Albert Needham lists a payment to "Rev. Dunham, minister at Funeral".  
The First Baptist Church web site lists Rev. Charles E. Dunham as pastor from September 6, 1917 to June 30, 1925.

An Akron, NY history page says the village of Akron was established in 1849. It was a village 20 years before that. The first town meeting was in 1805. There's a Hart street in Akron. The village of Akron is part of the town of Newstead.

The 11 Dec 1902 Pioneer Record of Ida Grove, Iowa (actually the 11 Dec 1952 paper, referring to the 1902) reads:

"A Needham and son attended the Poultry show at Castana Wednesday. He exhibited a number of his thoroughbred Wyandotte chickens and Perkin ducks. He reports a good attendance at the show."

Shows an Albert Needham, born in Erie Co. NY 27 april 1825. Not surprising - there are a bunch of Albert Needhams. I'm guessing this one is the son of Ephraim Needham of Concord, NY.

<http://www.rootsweb.com/~iaida/1884/1884logan.htm>, lists both an Albert and Frank Needham, along with a Eugene Needham. That directory doesn't list Emogine - I think that "Eugene" is a mistranscription of "Emogine". That directory also lists John Lambertson as living in the same household - a farm laborer. The Logan Township, Iowa was created in 1869.

Albert's pension application in Ida Grove in 1904 is witnessed by two people who claim to have known him for 20 years each: Wm. K. Van Wagoner, who is probably the W. K. Van Wagoner who owned a farm just to the northwest of Albert's farm, and A. H. Gray, who I haven't yet identified.

OLIVER B. NEEDHAM

Oliver Bardwell Needham, a retired Tacoma public school teacher, died Thursday in a local hospital. His home was at 1005 No. Cedar St. He was born in Ida Grove, Iowa, and came to Tacoma in 1929. He taught architectural drawing at Lincoln High School until his retirement in 1950. He was a member of the Retired Teachers Association and the Epworth Methodist Church. He is survived by his wife, Faye, and two daughters, Rosemary and Lois, all of the home. Services will be held Saturday at 1 p.m. in Tuell's Chapel, with the Rev. Harold C. Williams officiating. Cremation will follow. The family request that flowers be omitted and suggest instead that donations be made to the Tacoma Teachers Home Corporation.

Oliver's picture appears in the "Lincolnian", the Lincoln High School, Tacoma Washington, yearbook, 1931 through 1950.

Although the death certificate says Tacoma Mausoleum, Tacoma, Washington, the Tacoma Mausoleum reported that the state lists them as the final disposition of cremains even when they perform cremation on behalf of some other mortuary. The obit suggests that Tuell's mortuary handled the disposition of the cremains. Tuell-Mckee Funeral Home still exists (2005) - they may or may not have records of disposition.

Notes for John Foshay:

I don't have clear evidence of who John's mother was.

In correspondence between Percy Maxwell Foshay, John Foshay, and Rev. Milford Foshay, P. Max. Foshay believes that John Foshay is Elijah Foshay's eldest son. This is inconsistent with John Foshay's application to administer David C. Foshay's estate, in which John describes himself as a brother of David C. Foshay and Elijah Fowler Foshay, among other children of Peter Foshay.

A photo of John Foshay, that Jeffrey W. Bryant has scanned is labeled "Early Sand Ridge Teacher". An article from the Albany paper in January 2002 says: "Sand Ridge's origins date back to 1854, to a building that then existed about a mile northeast of the school's current location on Sand Ridge Road west of Lebanon." Later, the article says that the current Sand Ridge school (which had just closed) is at 31575 Sand Ridge Road.

The 1868 November 20 Portland Oregonian lists a John Foshay of Albany as staying in town (that was a time when the papers listed who was staying at the local hotels).

The Oregon State Archives has a military record for Foshay, \_\_\_: 1874 Foshay, \_\_\_ Military Linn. Archivist says no other info is in the record.

The 1870 Oregon Census shows a John Foshay in Linn County, sand ridge precinct - a school teacher.

John Foshay's obituary says that he setup his pharmacy in 1872.

The 1878 City of Albany Directory lists:

"Foshay, John, drugs, books and stationery, res s e cor Fourth and Lyon", and "Foshay, John, 106 West Front" is

listed under "Books and Stationery", "Druggists" (1 of 4 in town), and "Music and Instruments".

The 1880 Oregon Census shows John Foshay, born in New Brunswick, wife Martha, kids. Curiously, that census lists John Foshay's father as being born in New York and mother born in New Jersey, which is inconsistent with the other data I have. That census also lists the household as having a 20-year-old white female servant, Ida Wheeler, born in Missouri, whose parents were both born in Missouri.

P. Max Foshay writes in 1885 that he found this John Foshay  
"...by accident - in one of John B. Alden's [a book publisher of the time] book catalogues...." - what book was that?

The firm of John B. Alden published books from 1879 to 1908 in New York.

Linn Co. records show Riverside Cem. as est.1847, Township:  
11S4W12, lat/long (it's in Deg/min/sec) 443753N 1230706W Loc as Albany W. side of 6th St., Albany. The USGS topo map shows riverside cemetery (very large) at the west end of 6th street in Albany. The entry for John Foshay in Riverside cemetery is Foshay, John 10/15/1830 8/12/1909 30S. The 30S means the 30th row from the East entrance, on the South side of the cemetery.

An obit reads "PIERCEVILLE - Paul Harrison White, 64, died June 7, 2002, at St. Catherine's Hospital, Garden City [KS]. He was born July 6, 1937, at Cedar Vale, the son of John R. and Verna A. Huddle White. A resident of Pierceville since 1966, moving from Winfield, he worked as a manager for the Pierceville Co-op Elevator for 20 years before retiring. He served in the U.S. Marines.
